**WAIVER AND INDEMNITY**

'Football' - Means Australian Rules Football; 'Club' - Means **East Fremantle Junior Football Club**; 'League' - Means East Fremantle District Development Council Inc; 'Child' Means child or ward (whichever is applicable)

I am aware that playing Football, observing Football, learning to play Football and training to play Football, and participating in any activity carried out by the Club, are activities that inherently involve risk, and that in undertaking these activities my child does so at his/her own risk.

I am also aware that, as a condition of my child's admission to membership of the Club, its office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, umpires, members, and/or agents are absolved from all liability arising from injury or damage howsoever caused. That injury or damage may arise out of membership of the Club, playing Football, observing Football, learning to play Football and training to play Football, or negligence of any nature whatsoever on the part of the Club or League, their representatives, office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, umpires, members, and/or agents.

I understand and agree that nothing in this agreement purports to exclude any liability that may be owed by the Club or the League and their representatives pursuant to the provisions of any relevant Statutory Act/s covering these activities. To the extent that any part of this agreement may contravene any of the Statutory Act/s I agree that part of the agreement may be severed and rendered void but the rest of the agreement will remain valid and continue to have effect.

**I do hereby acknowledge that of my own free will and desire, I have contracted with the Club for the instruction, training and playing of my child in Football and that I have read and understood the above waiver.**

**PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT:**

1. Abide by the rules of the game and rules set down by your coach, club and district.
2. Respect and follow the directions of coaching staff, match and club officials.
3. Act respectfully toward the officials and players of the EFJFC as well as those from opposing Clubs
4. Co-operate with your coach and teammates, and respect the ability of your opponent. Without them there would be no game.
5. Never argue with an official or umpire. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your team manager who **may** then approach the official during a quarter break or after the game has been completed.
6. Control your temper. Verbal or physical abuse of officials, umpires, spectators or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted and won't help you enjoy or even win any games.
7. Be a team player, it's a team game so treat it that way and aim to work equally hard for both yourself and your team.
8. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are for your team, your opponent or the other team so that you can be proud to walk off the ground after each game knowing that you have given your best effort.
9. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, use derogatory language, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Your involvement to play is for fun and enjoyment and that winning is only part of it.
10. Play for the 'fun of it' and not just to please parents and coaches.
11. Attend training sessions and matches at times advised by the Club. If unable, for a valid reason to do so, players will inform the Club as soon, as is practical.
12. Respect the facilities and equipment of the EFJFC and those provided by opposing Clubs.

**PARENTS, SUPPORTERS AND OFFICIALS CODE OF CONDUCT:**

1. Remember children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
2. Encourage children to participate, do not force participation upon them.
3. Focus on your children's efforts and self-esteem rather than whether they win or lose.
4. Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
5. Never ridicule or yell at children for making a mistake or if their team loses a game.
6. Remember children learn best by example – applaud the efforts of all players in both teams.
7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
8. Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators – without whom your child could not participate.
9. Respect umpires' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
10. Remember smoking and the consumption of alcohol is unacceptable at junior sport.

By registering our child with the East Fremantle Junior Football Club, I / we agree to abide by these principles. I / we will ensure that our child understands the expected behaviour of an East Fremantle Power player. I / we support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, parents and or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct.
